**Seasonal Checklist**

- Spring Clean Up:** A thorough Spring clean up and weeding with a 2" application of a composted mulch will reduce your season's work by 80%. Spend your time on something other than weeding.
- Prune Roses & Hydrangeas:** The ideal time for this is as soon as the Forsythia blooms.
- Irrigation:** Irrigation system should be started up, all heads should be checked and cleaned, nozzles and rotors should be adjusted to ensure maximum coverage, and timers should be set. We recommend checking & adjusting your irrigation system every 6-8 weeks. Backflow tests must be completed once a year to ensure code compliance.
- Lawn Care:** If your lawn wasn't limed in the Fall, now is the time. Lawns should also be aerated, fertilized, top-dressed and over-seeded if necessary.
- Edibles:** It's the time to plant cool weather crops (e.g. peas, lettuce, spinach, radishes and carrots).
- Spring Bulbs & Annuals:** Now is the time to add colour to your pots, hanging baskets and annual beds. Consider Tulips, Aliums, English Daisies, Pansies, Daffodils or Jolly Jump-Ups.
- Landscape Lighting:** Check all fixtures & replace bulbs. It is a good time to upgrade to LED bulbs.
